The session aimed to welcome the 3rd Semester students to the Department of Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning and to present them with the key highlights of the department.



The session began with a welcome address by hosts – Arangan Shankar and Atulya Manikandan, followed by an invocation and lighting of the lamp accompanied by a prayer song, by Khushi.
